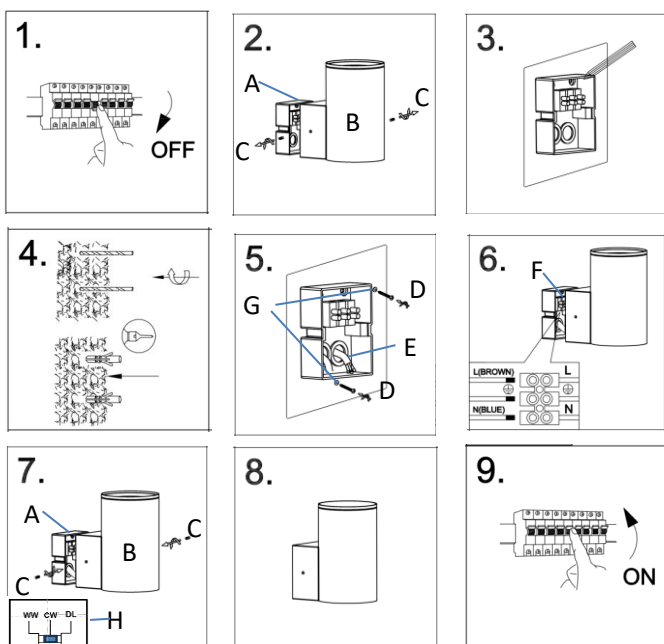

Before first using your new Brilliant exterior wall light it is most important that you read and follow these instructions, even if you feel you are quite familiar with this type of product. Keep this document handy for future reference.

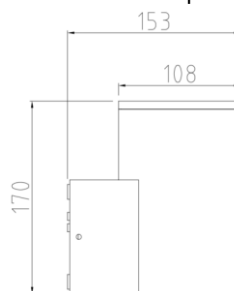
For Your Safety

- To prevent electrical shock, please ensure that power is DISCONNECTED before installing.
- During use the light shade and/or light assembly may become hot.
- Do not install in a position where the fitting can be easily accessed by children or the infirm.
- Do not touch any parts of the assembly with bare hands while it is 'ON'.
- Be aware of the height of your installation. Refer to 'Working at Heights' guide from your local or State Authorities.
- Any alterations or additions to building wiring must be completed by a licensed electrician or person authorised by legislation to work on the fixed wiring of any electrical installation.



WARNING:

- This fitting has no user serviceable parts.
- Ensure the product is installed in correct orientation to maintain IP rating.
- Do not stare at the operating LED light source.
- This fitting must be earthed.
- Failure to follow these instructions may result in breakages and will invalidate warranty.
- For safety reasons, any installation, repair or inspection must be done by authorized personnel
- Do not perform modification or change parts within the light fixture.
- Apply silicone if required around the base plate and/or cable if required to maintain IP rating.



Installation Instructions

1. Ensure mains supply is switched OFF and unpack the fixture carefully and place it on a flat surface.
2. Use Allen Key to remove metal cover 'A' from light 'B' by unscrewing the two hexagon socket screws 'C'.
3. After finding the appropriate mounting location, mark the installation screw holes with a pen.
4. Drill two holes and drive the rawl plugs into the wall.
5. Align the screw holes of the mounting plate with the rawl plugs and close to the wall, then pierce the washers (G) with the screws (D), lock them and feed the mains supply cable through wall. Pierce the rubber grommet 'E' with a screwdriver and pass the mains supply cable through.
6. Connect the Live (L), Neutral (N) and Earth (E) according to the markings on the terminal block 'F'.
7. Use the colour temperature switch (H) to choose the colour temperature according to your personal preference, DL is day light, CW is cool white, and WW is warm white. Refit the metal cover 'A' to the light 'B', securing it in place using two hexagon socket screws 'C'. Tighten the screws firmly.
8. Reconnect the mains supply.
9. Turn on the wall light.

You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
